II. Roll Call & Establishment of Quorum

- a. Members present: Melissa Moreno, Sharon Brown, Ray McDonald

III. Welcome from the Chair Dr. Melissa V. Moreno

- a. Melissa welcomes all attendees. Melissa asks for a moment of silence in solidarity and to honor George Floyd. b. Consortium Member update
 - i. Ray relays the Workforce continues to be heavily impacted moving service deliveries online. He describes the tremendous amount of layoffs due to the closures and relays that Workforce services can be found online on the Workforce website. There has been a significant uptick in unemployment in April from 4% to 18.7%. Ray is looking for plans for short-terms employment Workforce opportunities. He will be reaching out to our Consortium partners as updates on these plans become available.
 - ii. Sharon relays she is keeping a close eye on the Governor's upcoming announcements and how they will impact career technical education in our K-12 schools. There are new grants coming in, in addition to Strong Workforce, to hopefully ensure that schools will keep the pipeline integrated with our community colleges.
- c. Melissa relays that the Strong Workforce grant has suffered a 60% reduction. The CAEP grant has been reduced by 12.1%.
- d. CAEP Director Corlei Prieto provides announcements and legislative updates
 - i. Corlei relays that the 12.1% does not impact our year 4 or year 5 allocations. It will only impact the year 6 allocation. The reduction will likely mirror our 1st year allocation \$750,000.
